## **Professor Rosemary O'Leary**

Distinguished Professor of Public Administration and International Affairs The Maxwell School of Syracuse University



Rosemary O'Leary holds many titles: Distinguished Professor of Public Administration and International Affairs, Phanstiel Chair of Strategic Management and Leadership, and Birkhead-Burkhead Professor of Teaching Excellence...all at the Maxwell School of Syracuse University. She is the author or editor of eleven books and more than 100 articles and book chapters on public management. She has won ten national research awards and nine teaching awards. She is the only person to win three National Association of Schools of Public Affairs and Administration awards for Best Dissertation (1989), Excellence in Teaching (1996) and Distinguished Research (2004). An elected member of the National Academy of Public Administration, O'Leary was a senior Fulbright scholar in Malaysia and in the Philippines. From 2003 to 2005 O'Leary was a member of the NASA's Return to Flight Task Group assembled in response to the Columbia space shuttle accident. She also has served as a consultant to the U.S. Department of the Interior, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, the Indiana Department of Environmental Management, the International City/County Management Association, the National Science Foundation, and the National Academy of Sciences. Her areas of expertise are public management, collaboration, conflict resolution, environmental and natural resources management, and public law. Her current research is on collaboration as a management and leadership strategy.
